What is Green Arena?

- Developing farms on the countryside offering services whithin social care, education and health.
- The environment on the countryside together with the animals on the farm and the nature are an important part of the concept.
- We work with both sides





Green Arena – a short history

- Started in Värmland in 2006
- National project since January 2013, funded by EU and the Swedish government.
- A turning point in Sweden for the public service provision

Green Arena – how do we work?

- All over Sweden
- 8 regional areas
- 8 project leaders, knowing the "local" conditions is important





We have developed Green Arena concepts within three areas

- Social care
- Education
- Health and recreation





Social care

- Daily activities for physically and mentally disabled people
- Daily activities for older people and older people in early stadge of demetia.
- Activities and training for people in social psychiatry.
- Meaningful activities for children and youth with special needs.
- Support to family members that takes care of their relevants with illness
- Integration of imigrants





The farm as an educational resource

- Alternative school for pupils
- Schools can visit the farm in groups
- Activities after end of school day
- For unaccompanied children from other countries.





Health and recreation

- Feel good acitivities in the nature, with animals and garden.
- Courses in stress management
- Camp acivities for children and youth
- Tailor made activeties for recreation and recovery

Various forms of cooperation with Green Arena farms

The municipality buys a complete service package with everything included

The municipality buys a number of heads and pays for other expenses.

The farmer is employed by the municipality and carries out agreed activities on the farm.

The municipality rents the farm with the farmer as tutor and bring their own specific personal.
